Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday, August 25, 2020, the undersigned on behalf of NTCA-The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA") spoke with Preston Wise, wireline advisor to Chairman Ajit Pai.

During this conversation, I expressed concerns about the impacts of the resurgent budget control mechanism on rural local exchange carriers receiving cost-based Connect America Fund-Broadband Loop Support and/or High Cost Loop Support. This mechanism will reduce by more than \$37 million over the next twelve-month period the amount of universal service support to be received by several hundred small rural companies and cooperatives that are currently making every effort to keep Americans connected and to keep their networks running in the face of a national emergency. I therefore requested that the effectiveness of the budget control be waived for the pendency of the COVID-19 national emergency. The continued availability of these funds would sustain essential operations at a time when smaller providers are facing unprecedented challenges in keeping Americans connected and customer uncollectibles remain high.
