2024 Youth Tour CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students shall abide by all Youth Tour rules in a manner that honors their family, school, and the NTCA member that sponsored their participation.
2. Students shall respect and abide by the authority entrusted to the FRS staff and chaperones.
3. Except when in their hotel room, Students shall at all times be under the supervision of their assigned chaperone or FRS staff.
4. Students must stay in housing designated by FRS during the tour.
5. Students shall participate in authorized activities only.
6. Boys are not permitted in girls' rooms and girls are not permitted in boys' rooms *at any time* – unless an adult supervisor is present.
7. Students shall not possess or use any alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs at *any* time, under *any* circumstances.
8. Use of tobacco, including electronic cigarettes, vaping, and chewing tobacco, is *not* permitted.
9. Students will adhere to dress regulations established for the FRS Youth Tour. Students are expected to act in a respectful manner and to avoid inappropriate attire. Examples of inappropriate attire include, but are not limited to, clothing with profanity, nude or semi-nude photos, or sexually suggestive photos or messages. In addition, because FRS is a non-partisan organization, clothing with political slogans, political advertisements, and politically suggestive cartoons or drawings is not allowed.
10. FRS Youth Tour identification badges must be worn as directed.

A violation of this Code of Conduct will result in notification to the student's parent(s) or guardian and the sponsoring company, and the student will be sent home at the sponsoring company's expense.
