On Wednesday, January 20, 2016, the undersigned, on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA"), met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn; her legal advisor, Rebekah Goodheart; Commissioner Michael O'Rielly; his chief of staff, Robin Colwell; Stephanie Weiner, legal advisor to Chairman Tom Wheeler; and Matthew DelNero and Carol Mattey of the Wireline Competition Bureau. Genevieve Morelli of ITTA-The Voice of Mid-Sized Communications Companies and Lynn Follansbee of USTelecom were also present in the meeting.

During the meeting, I stated NTCA's support for a simple and straightforward means of updating existing universal service mechanisms to enable support of standalone broadband services specifically. In particular, I expressed NTCA's support in the first instance for the establishment of such a mechanism that could work separate from, but alongside, existing mechanisms to support standalone broadband. I further indicated NTCA's willingness and eagerness, however, to discuss other measures – such as modifications to the existing mechanisms – that could be adopted to achieve a similar result.
