Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Thursday, January 21, 2016, the undersigned, on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA"), spoke via telephone with Travis Litman, legal advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel, regarding matters in the above-referenced proceeding. Specifically, we discussed the need to ensure that any limits on costs recoverable though universal service are carefully designed and subject to reasonable transitions, and that, to the maximum extent possible, sunk costs associated with prior investments should remain eligible for recovery under the rules that were in place at the time such investments were made. I noted that these goals should be achievable under any approach to reform of underlying distribution calculations that might be pursued, and expressed NTCA's eagerness for a detailed conversation surrounding the proper development and application of any such measures in coming days and weeks.
