Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Monday, January 25, 2016, the undersigned, on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA"), spoke via telephone with Carol Mattey and Suzanne Yelen of the Wireline Competition Bureau regarding matters in the above-referenced proceeding.

Specifically, we discussed options for reforming existing universal service mechanisms to achieve goals articulated by Congress, the Federal Communications Commission (the "Commission"), and NTCA members who serve in the most rural areas of the country. NTCA urged in particular that the Commission should and can undertake reforms that enable cost-based recovery for the delivery of standalone broadband services where consumers demand such services, while also avoiding disruption with respect to the recovery of prior investments in accordance with rules and expectations in place at the time those investments were made.
