On Tuesday, February 2, 2016, the undersigned on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA") and Denny Law of Golden West Communications held separate meetings with: (1) Nicholas Degani, legal advisor to Commissioner Ajit Pai; (2) Travis Litman, legal advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel; and (3) Amy Bender, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly, and Carol Mattey, Deputy Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau.

In each meeting, we discussed options for reforming existing universal service support mechanisms to provide standalone broadband support.
