On Friday, June 12, 2015, the undersigned, on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association, together with Gerry Duffy on behalf of WTA-Advocates for Rural Broadband, Genevieve Morelli on behalf of ITTA-The Voice of Mid-Size Communications Companies, and Lynn Follansbee on behalf of the United States Telecom Association met with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly and his legal advisor, Amy Bender, Rebekah Goodheart, legal advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn (participating via telephone), and Carol Mattey, Deputy Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau, regarding issues presented in the above-referenced proceedings.
