On Thursday, October 8, 2015, the undersigned on behalf of NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association ("NTCA"), spoke via telephone with Amy Bender, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly, to discuss matters in the above-referenced proceedings.

Specifically, NTCA discussed materials recently submitted by the association and other rural telecom stakeholders related to suggestions by certain Federal Communications Commission (the "Commission") offices for potential reforms of federal universal service support mechanisms. *See Ex Parte* Letter from Lynn Follansbee, USTelecom, to Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, Commission, WC Docket No. 10-90 (filed Sept. 25, 2015). NTCA discussed the need for clarity regarding questions that are still outstanding on the current record relating to those ideas and other potential aspects of reform, as well as the ongoing efforts necessary to understand, examine, and analyze such concepts and proposals. *See Ex Parte* Letter from Lynn Follansbee, USTelecom, to Marlene H.
